*An Award of the Mining Society of Nova Scotia*

*Purpose*

To recognize exceptional service to the Mining Industry in the Province of Nova Scotia

*General Guidelines for Selection*

The Award will be presented at the Annual General Meeting of the Mining Society of Nova Scotia. However, it is not imperative that a winner be named each year.

Service to the industry in Nova Scotia may be a variety of activities including, for example, engineering, metallurgy, prospected, geology, government and financial services.

The quality of “exceptional service” will be the key factor. This would usually follow from a lifetime of consistently high work but a single outstanding achievement may be considered.

Membership in the society is not an essential factor, but the service being recognized must be directly related to the Province of Nova Scotia.

*Selection Committee and Nomination*

The committee call the Awards Committee” will be responsible for selecting the person to be honored. The Committee will request nominations from the general membership of the society. Members of the committee may also introduce nominations. Supporting documentation must accompany the nomination. The date for the close of nominations will be sixty (60) days prior to the Annual Meeting.

The selection will be decided upon by the President, and the last four Presidents, resident in Nova Scotia
